3. About the Course

The course entitled: "*Great Aspirational Prayers for Peace and Happiness*" combines explanatory teachings on a Drupchen and intensive prayers for the world's peace during the actual Drupchen.

The course is open to all and will run from 5 to 15 April 2010.

Dead-line for enrolment is 20th of March 2010.

4. Course location

The course will take place in Tbilisi, Georgia. The working language of the course is English. Interpretation corners may be set up for groups of students who do not understand English. Interpretation will be done on a voluntary basis. The course material: Sadhana on Vajrasattva Drupchen will be published in Tibetan with (partial) English translation. Subsequent translations of texts into other languages may be

arranged by local centres, and published under the supervision of Wisdom Treasury s.p.r.l.

5. Numbers of participants

The Course will run with a minimum of 25 and a maximum of 150 participants.

Minimum number of participants: if the minimum number of enrolled students is not reached on the deadline for enrolment, the course will be cancelled.

Maximum number of participants: once the limit has been reached, further enrolments will not be accepted, and information about the end of the enrolment process will be put on the website.

6. Enrolment

Each participant must fill in an Enrolment Form and submit it complete and signed.

Participants will only be enrolled when a valid Enrolment Form has been received. The enrolment process is as follows:

- a) forms will be checked and cross-checked for validity;
- b) valid enrolments will be acknowledged;
- c) invalid enrolments will not be accepted and requests for correct information will be sent out;
- d) enrolled participants will be sent additional information.

7. Under-age participants

Participants which have not reached the age of majority must fill in an Enrolment Form and submit it complete and signed. Those who want to attend alone without their parents, or guardians, must sign the Guardian Consent and send it back along with their Enrolment Form.

8. Non-Participants

Children up to 14 years old who do not participate in the course are allowed.

Child Care

Full-time childcare is not provided. Parents take full responsibility for their children welfare. Children must have adult supervision at all times. There will be opportunities to set up trades with other parents. Parents should consider bringing toys, art supplies, games, snacks and some quiet activities appropriate for occupying children's time. Children are welcome in the shrine room as long as they sit quietly. If your child becomes uncomfortable, please take care of her or him outside of the shrine room.

Adults who do not participate in the courses, but who require meals are allowed.

Non-Participant Form

Non-Participant Form is on our website. It has to be filled in for each child or adult who accompanies a participant, and submitted complete and signed.

9. Accommodation Camping or Dormitory

In Tbilisi, there are two possibilities:

- To book a spot in a dormitory, which can accommodate up to 30 persons in total; participants must have their own sleeping bag and a bed-sheet.
- Participants can find information about other accommodation possibilities on the webpage of the Drupchen (cf. §2).

10. Meals

Course fees include 3 meals a day. The meals are vegetarian.

We will try to prepare special meals only for those who, for medical reasons, require different diet (please, mention about it in your enrolment form).

11. Tasks during the course

For the well running of the course everyone is requested to help for approximately 1 hour a day. Tasks ranges from administration to cooking & cleaning, etc. Please mention your preferred tasks in the "notes" section of the enrolment form.

12. Level of comfort

While the organisers will do their best to provide as comfortable circumstances as possible for the courses to take place, participants should be aware that the level of comfort is fairly simple. Participants are invited to bring along both a mat and a cushion. They will also be able to buy them on site.

13. Copyright

14. Cancellations

15. Visa for Georgia

Note: EU citizens do not need a Visa.

We can make an invitation letter for students who wish to attend the whole course and who have sent a correctly filled enrolment form before the 20th of March.

In addition to the information requested in the enrolment form, please send us information about: 1. your nationality, 2. birthday, 3. passport number, 4. the fax of the Georgian embassy in your country of residence.

Let us know at least 2 weeks before beginning of the course.

16. Refusals & Expulsions

The organisers reserve the exclusive right to grant or refuse admission to the courses and to the property of the course premises. Those who have disturbed courses in the past may be refused admission. Those with mental disabilities or impairments, who might be troubled by the content of the Course, will not have their enrolment accepted.

Participants or accompanying non-participants committing serious disciplinary offences, repeated bad behaviour or infringements of the laws and customs of the country in which the courses are taking place, will be expelled from the course and from the course premises at the sole discretion of the organisers and without any right to a refund or reinstatement, unless otherwise decided by the organisers.

17. Personal effects insurance

The organisers do not take responsibility, or accept liability, for the loss, theft or damage of the participants' personal property, for which they recommend that participants take out their own insurance policy.

18. Medical insurance

Participants must have their own medical insurance in order to attend the courses and are

advised to ensure that they are adequately covered. The organisers' insurance does not cover personal accidents, illness, psychological care, hospitalisation or transportation. Participants are required to bring and administer any prescribed medication.

Tibetan Buddhist teachings and practices during the course are not intended to be substitutes for psychotherapy. If participants have psychological or psychiatric problems, the organisers recommend that they consult their doctor or therapist before embarking on the enrolment process. If you disregard this information the organisers can not be held responsible.

Participants are not allowed to exercise any lucrative activities during the course or outside it in relation to any aspect to the course.

Pets are not allowed on the premises.

Smoking and alcohol are forbidden on the premises.

19. Disclaimer

The organisers, while being fully committed to the well-being of everyone who participates in the course, or accompanies a participant to it, are not travel agents, hoteliers or event organisers, and are not acting in any of these capacities. They do not take responsibility, or accept liability, for any difficulties or misadventures that may occur during, or in relation to, the courses.
